

# FAA INSTRUMENT RATING

## FAA REQUIREMENTS

- ✓ Be at least 17 years of age
- ✓ Hold a private pilot helicopter certificate
- ✓ Hold an FAA medical certificate
- ✓ Pass an FAA written examination
- ✓ Pass an FAA oral and flight test
- ✓ Obtain 50 hours of XC PIC and 40 hours simulated instrument time.



## INSTRUMENT RATING

An IFR rating allows you to fly in a helicopter according to IFR (Instrument Flight Rules).

## AERONAUTICAL EXPERIENCE

Must have FAA private pilot certificate that consist of at least:

- ✓ 50 hours XC PIC and 10 hours must be in helicopters
- ✓ 40 hours of simulated instrument time which includes at least 15 hours in a helicopter with an authorized flight instructor must include of:
  - 3 hours of IFR training in a helicopter within 2 calendar months before the practical test.
  - One IFR XC training in a helicopter at least 100 nm along airways with 3 different kinds of approaches.

## INSTRUMENT RATING ADD-ON HELICOPTER

- ✓ 10 hours of PIC XC in a helicopter
- ✓ 15 hours of IFR training in a helicopter
